

were in attendance. A special thank you to the Ladies Auxiliary, Honor Guard and the kitchen staff.



#### The following is an abbreviated history of Bismarck AMVETS Post #9

- 1. The Bismarck AMVETS Post #9 was incorporated with the State of North Dakota on March 3, 1986.
- It is a nonprofit veteran's organization and is under the control and supervision of the national AMVETS organization and officers.
- It currently operates as an IRC 50l(c)(19) and is exempts from federal income tax.
- 4. The Bismarck AMVETS Post #9 must be operated for one or more of the 8 purposes listed below to retain exempt IRC 50l(c)(19) status. The exempt purposes are:
  - a. Promotion of the social welfare of the community;
  - Assisting disabled and needy war veterans and members of the U.S. Armed Forces and their dependents and the widows and orphans of deceased veterans;

- c. Providing entertainment, care and assistance to hospitalized veterans or members of the U.S.Armed Forces;
- Carrying on programs to perpetuate the memory of deceased veterans and members of the Armed Forces, and to comfort their survivors;
- e. Conducting programs for religious, charitable, scientific, literacy, or educational purposes;
- Sponsoring or participating in activities of a patriotic nature;
- Providing insurance benefits for their members or dependents of their members, or both; and
- h. Providing social and recreational activities
- for its members. 5. On August 1, 1989, the Bismarck AMVETS
- Post #9 leases from the North Dakota Safety Council, Inc. the building and adjacent parking lot located at 2402 Rail-road Avenue Bismarck, North Dakota for \$2,700.00/month. The leased property is more accurately described as Lots 13 -24 inclusively, of Block 42, Governor Pierce Addition to the City of Bismarck, together with vacated roadway and alleys,
- On February 4, 1991, the Bismarck AMVETS Post #9 receives from the North Dakota Safety Council, Inc. a Warranty Deed for the building and property more accurately described as Lots 13 - 24 inclusively, of Block 42, Governor Pierce Addition to the City of Bismarck, together with vacated roadway and alleys, for the consideration of \$235,000.00,
- 7. On February 21, 1991, the Bismarck AMVETS Post #9 purchases from the ND Safety Council all personal property, fixtures and equipment at the property more accurately described as Lots 13-24 inclusively, of Block 42, Governor Pierce Addition to the City of Bismarck, together with vacated roadway and alleys, for \$24,000,
- On January 7, 1997, Bismarck AMVETS Post #9 purchased from James and Betty Mohler the building and associated property more accurately described as lots 1-12 inclusively, of Block 42, Governor Pierce Addition to the City of Bismarck, together with vacated roadway and alleys, excluding the northeasterly portions of Lots 1-4 that lie within the right of way of the Minneapolis, Saint Paul and Sault Saint Marie Railroad Company for \$154,000. The Bis-marck AMVETS Post #9 currently leases the building and property on Lots 9-2, Block 42, Governor Pierce Addition to the City of Bismarck to an independent party.
- In January of 1997 the Bismarck AMVETS Post #9 undertook a remodeling effort that produced the footprint of the building as it exists today. The project included bathroom modifications, elevator improvements, front entrance improvements and other items to provide compliance with ADA requirements.
- 10.Current membership is approximately 1,100.
